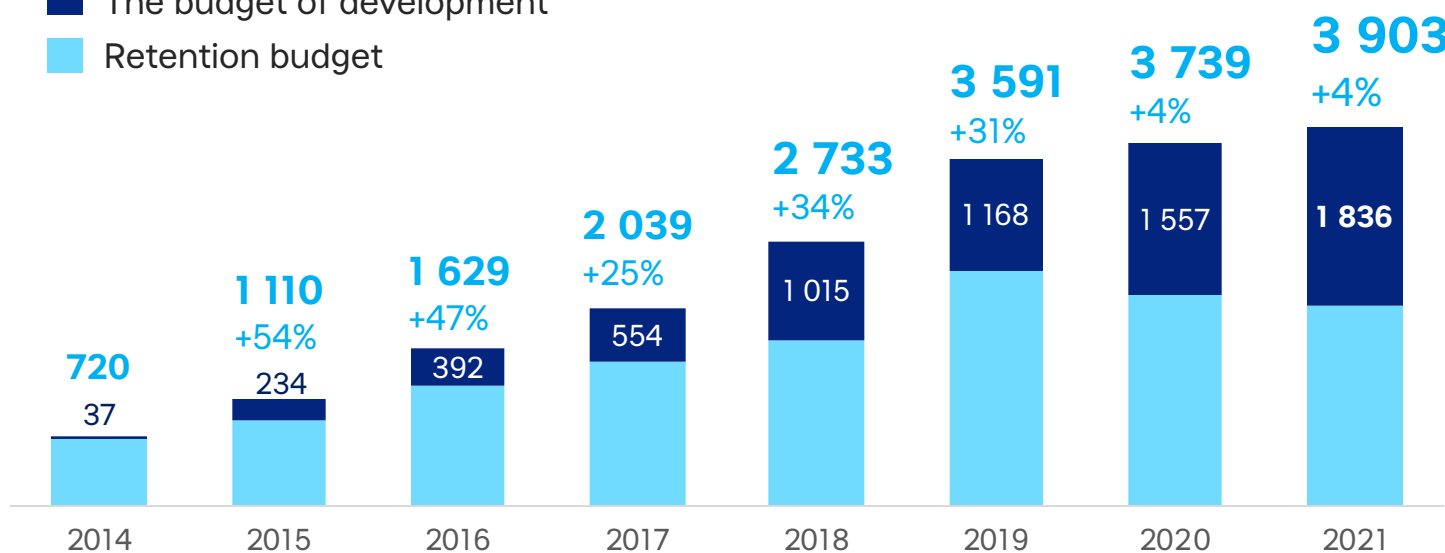

Development of “AzovAquaInvest” industrial park



“AzovAquaInvest” Industrial Park

Is located in the city of Mariupol and entered in the register of Industrial Parks of Ukraine on 07.02.2019.

Features:

- The total area of the industrial park is 15.5 hectares (including the main part of 9.06 hectares).
- Form of ownership: municipal.
- The park unites 12 investment locations.
- There is a sea pier and a railway branch in the park.
- Convenient car entrances to the park.
- Convenient logistics destinations in Ukraine and Europe.



Mariupol - today

Development of “AzovAquaInvest” industrial park

Advantages for investors:

- Supply of utilities (electricity, gas, water and drainage) to the site is performed by the municipality;
- Rent for the use of land - 1% of the monetary value of the land;
- Start of land lease payment - from the moment of completion of construction of the investment object;
- Lease of land for 30 years;
- Management of the industrial park - carried out by the utility company;
- Support of investors from the initial stage;
- Exemption from duty (according to the law).

Expected benefits (according to the bills):

- State compensation for the costs of connection and connection to the electrical grid;
- State compensation of interest payments on loans depending on the share of exports of own production in the total income from their economic activity (maximum - up to 70% of the total amount of interest payments on the loan);
- State compensation of interest rates on loans for industrial parks;
- Partial state compensation of investments of participants of industrial parks in the creation of production, carried out during the first three years of economic activity within the industrial park (maximum - up to 70% of the total investment depending on the share of exports in total income);

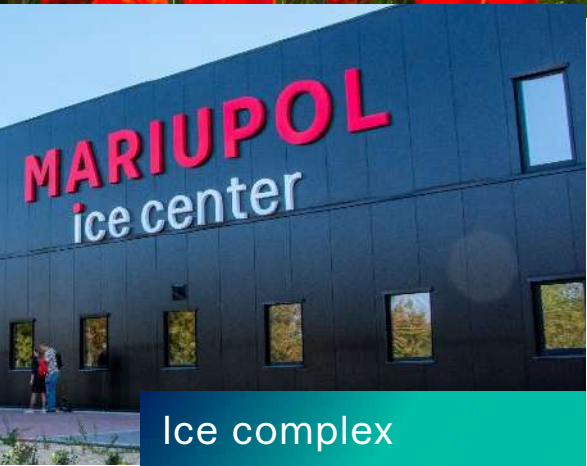
